Store at -20°C to 80°C for 12 months in lyophilized form. After reconstitution, if not intended for use within a month, aliquot and store at -80°C (Avoid repeated freezing and thawing). Lyophilized proteins are shipped at ambient temperature. The protein encoded by this gene is a receptor protein by rosine kinase and type it transmembrane protein that belongs to the ROB subfamily of cell surface receptors. The protein may be involved in the early formation of the chondrocytes and may be required for cardiage and growth plate development. Mutations in this gene can cause brachydactyly type B; a seleted isdisorder characterized by hypoplasia-palsais of distal phalanges and nails. In addition; mutations in this gene can cause the autosomal recessive form of Robinow syndrome; which is characterized by skeletal dysplasia with generalized limb bone shortening; segmental defects of the spine; brachydactyly; and a dysmorphic facial appearance.
